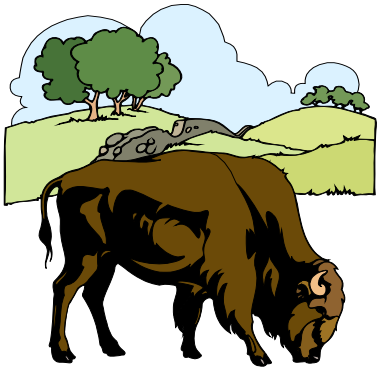

The fruit of the Spirit is ...PEACE Galatians 5:22

"Peace, peace, wonderful peace, coming down from the Father above ..." are lyrics from an old hymn. Everyone would like peace and tranquility in their life rather than turmoil and frustration, and God is more than willing to give us peace. When we made the choice to trust Christ as our personal Savior, we experienced peace with God. (Romans 5:1) Beyond this, is the promise of having the peace of God. This is an inner peace, not external as suggested in John 16:33, "These things I have spoken unto you, that in me you might have peace. In the world you shall have tribulation..." Peace will come to this earth only when Jesus returns to establish Himself as the authority here, so for now we must learn to depend on the "inner" peace that He gives. A favorite verse of mine is Isaiah 26:3 "Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on Thee: because he trusteth in thee." This verse teaches that peace stems from my complete trust in God. The next verse in this passage says "Trust ye in the Lord forever: for in the Lord JEHOVAH is everlasting strength." The word trust means to have faith and believe but even more specifically it means to take refuge, to lean on. Peace will come as we discipline our minds to stay focused on the Lord. We can also rest assured that He is most trustworthy. I encourage you to read over the words of the hymn, Wonderful Peace by W.G. Cooper. May the Lord use them to bring peace to your heart and mind.
